Sicame UK Limited is part of a Global business, owned by Sicame SA, who specialise in the following product/industry segments:

- Electricity distribution and network supply operators using a range of overhead & underground, transmission and distribution, LV and MV products for domestic and industrial applications.
- Cable contractors working on new build and contestable connections of the LV & MV distribution and transmission network.
- Distribution board manufacture for multiple dwelling locations.
- Railway electricity transmission and distribution projects and maintenance.
- Subsea cable accessories for MV oil and gas and renewable energy generation projects.

Sicame UK Limited was established in 2014 and compromises of three trading divisions:
